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ON NATIONAL LAWS



- Joint facilitation/provision of trainings to strengthen the institutional capacities for inter-ministerial coordination, implementation & monitoring
- Develop country partner capacities to ensure that GBV laws are in place/improve them through legal reforms and strengthened enforcement mechanisms
- Provide TA and advocacy support to institutionalize VAW/GBV issues in portfolios of NHRCs, SHRCs, RHRCs
- Develop capacities of relevant law enforcement officials & uniformed personnel to adhere to relevant laws and ensure redress and reparations

ON NATIONAL ACTION PLANS



- Support various components of the existing NPAs according to agency mandate
- Provide TA and capacity development to develop NPAs in country where these do not exist
- Promote adequate budgetary allocations in NPAs

ON DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS



- Work collectively with regional and national institutes to strengthen and improve data collection, analyses and surveys on VAW/GBV
- Partner to support national/sub-national surveys for monitoring prevalence at national, sub-national and community levels
- Work together to strengthen benchmarks and indicators on VAW/GBV programming (to enable quality monitoring)

NATIONAL AND/OR LOCAL CAMPAIGNS



- Joint support to global and regional events such as sensitization workshops and campaigns
- Engage constituency members - that each agency works with - on advocacy initiatives (FBOs, community leaders, customary and traditional gatekeepers, men and boys, etc)

SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN CONFLICT



- Working to enlist the participation of and promotion of the leadership and decision-making roles of women in policy & legislative frameworks, including at the various UN levels (like GenCap Officers)
- Mainstreaming gender into CCAs and UNDAFs, including delineating/ear-marking appropriate budgets to implement gender-based and focused programmes in conflict prevention, early recovery, relief and peace building processes
- Pooling in of technical expertise – for developing capacities of various multi-stakeholders



- Resources (technical, financial and human)
- Scramble for limited resources
- Politics and visibility
- Coordination challenges

EXISTING COLLABORATIONS

- UN INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE PILOTING ON VAW IN 10 COUNTRIES
- Provides a key platform to scale up to other countries – in all 10 countries, UNFPA working with UNDP and UNDP RC is supporting the process
